selection criteria

Note that all selection criteria must be met in order for an applicant to be considered for any form of scholarship offered by UC Accommodation Student Village (UCA).

Required criteria to be included with completed application form:

Four accommodation scholarships are available to students residing at CLV Villages (University Hall, Ilam Apartments, Sonoda Christchurch Campus) who will use their skills and experience to positively impact the community at the hall, as a resident and in their capacity as a Student representative.

Eligibility criteria and scholarship descriptions are as outlined below:

University Hall leadership scholarship

Applicants must have been at high school during the 2021 academic year.

This scholarship will be awarded to one first year student who provides a robust proposal on sustainable initiatives that could be implemented at University Hall (incorporating ideas to engage residents) in either:

1. Environmental – energy saving, ecosystems/bio-diversity, etc.
2. Social – establishing a program to support First Year residents transitioning to independent living

(Applicable for University Hall)

Maori/Pacific Islander Scholarship

Applicants must be of Maori or Pacific Islander background.

This scholarship is a specific program designed to support one Maori or Pacific Islander student, who actively participates in the promotion of Residential Life cultural and arts initiatives for fellow residents.

(Applicable for University Hall, Ilam Apartments, Sonoda Christchurch Campus)

First in Family Scholarship

Applicants must be the first of their immediate family to attend University.

This scholarship is a specific program whereby CLV will support one 1st year NZ resident, who is the first of their family to attend University.

(Applicable for University Hall, Ilam Apartments)

2nd Year Scholarship

Applicants must be intending to be a 2nd year student at The University of Canterbury during the 2022 academic year.

This scholarship is a specific program whereby CLV will support one 2nd year student who can demonstrate the value of their skills and experience to positively influence their hall community.

(Applicable to Ilam Apartments and Sonoda Christchurch Campus)

applicants must also submit an essay of max 500 words outlining:

1. The basis on which they have applied and what they hope to achieve during their University Career, AND;
2. Their achievements to date, AND;
3. The impact that the prize money would have on their future work AND;
4. How they will use their skills and experience to positively impact the community at CLV Villages (University Hall, Ilam Apartments, Sonoda Christchurch Campus), as a resident and in their capacity as a CLV Student Association representative.

other eligibility criteria & conditions of entry

- The following guidelines apply to all scholarships offered by Campus Living Villages NZ Limited (CLVNZ) &UCA.
- All recipients of scholarships will be determined by UCA based upon the criteria and eligibility outlined above. However, not all candidates meeting these criteria will necessarily be awarded scholarships.
- UCA reserves the right to not award scholarships in a year if no candidates are considered suitable by the scholarship selection panel.
- The UCA Scholarships are \$2,500 payment against accommodation fees.
- Scholarship amounts are paid in New Zealand dollars.
- Scholarship recipients must be enrolled as full-time students* and must reside in the accommodation for the year the scholarship has been awarded. Part-time and distance learning applicants are not eligible.
*A full-time student is defined as 0.8 EFTS over 32 weeks.
- Applicants must hold current NZ Citizenship or NZ Residency, or a valid Student Visa. UCA retains the right to be the final arbiter of an applicant's eligibility.
- If a scholarship recipient leaves the accommodation, withdraws from their course of study, leaves university altogether or otherwise breaches the specific criteria of eligibility as listed above, their scholarship will be terminated with immediate effect and lump sum payment is recharged on a pro-rata basis.
- Scholarships may be terminated if UCA deems the following:
 - Unsatisfactory academic performance (such as falling below the required academic standards to continue at university).
 - The recipient acts in a way so as to bring UCA community or the University into disrepute.
- All recipients of the UCA Scholarships are expected to participate in their hall or village community. On receipt of the scholarship they will be expected to meet with the Village Manager or Marketing Manager to confirm their role in the community. They may be required from time to time for publicity and agree to have their photo used for promotional or Marketing purposes.
- UCA accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise from the grant of a scholarship to a scholarship recipient. Applicants should seek independent financial advice prior to lodging their application for a scholarship.
- The scholarships are subject to the scholars achieving university entrance.

- UCA Scholarships can be held alongside any other scholarship with the exception of the UC, Go Canterbury scholarship.
- A UCA Scholarship will only be awarded to applicants residing at University Hall, Ilam Apartments or Sonoda Christchurch Campus
- Applicants who meet the criteria for the Go Canterbury scholarship may not apply for the UCA Scholarship and are encouraged to submit an application for the former award.
- Scholarship applications are due 24th September 2021. Successful recipients will be announced 30th November 2021.
